CPO CERTIFICATES

CPO WALLET CARD

A wallet card will be mailed along with the certificate. The card, a miniature version of the certificate, also carries the graduate's personal registration number.

Introduction to the CPO -
an introduction to the Certified Pool Operator out line of course contents.

Swimming Pool Calculations -
the mathematics necessary to successfully operate a commercial swimming facility.

Liability and Safety Issues -
a presentation of the safety and liability considerations that are inherent in aquatic management.

Health Codes and Regulations -
a standard of operation that is required in order to comply with both industry and government.

Pool Water Chemistry -
careful consideration of the various aspects of water chemistry that affect swimming pools, including the saturation index.

Water Testing and Analysis -
Education of water testing equipment to determine chemistry and adjustment parameters of your pool and spa.

Filtration and Circulation -
Discussion of filtration, recirculation and various equipment used in the operation of pools and spas.

Spas, Tubs, and Hydrotherapy -
Heat and turbulence in small bodies of water lead to some unique problems with chemistry and maintenance.

Pool Management -
an overview of aquatic facility management plans of operation, with illustrations for recordkeeping, training of staff, scheduling, and budget planning.

Maintenance and Operations -
routine and preventative maintenance are discussed, along with operational parameters.

Seasonal Pool Care -
Unplanned shutdown procedures can be costly, especially for outdoor pools.

Energy Conservation & Management -
factors involved as well as methods to deal with energy loss.

Renovation and Modernization -
new products and services offer alternatives for updating and improving.

Disease and Accident Prevention -
full discussion of pool water as a disease carrier, along with prevention methods. Accident avoidance through risk management. Hazard Communication Program.
